1405: Extra-Curricular Activities

Policy

The Board supports the concept of extra-curricular activities as they relate to the education of students in School District 82 (Coast Mountains). Extra-curricular activities are those school activities not prescribed as part of the curriculum and operating outside of school hours, but with the approval and under the control of the school's administration.

For Field Trips and Outdoor Education, see Policy 1215.

Regulations

The Board of School Trustees encourages extra-curricular activities within the following regulations:

1. Schools must endeavor to make all extra-curricular activities self-supporting. The Board does not commit itself financially in any way when granting approval for the operation of extra-curricular activities.
2. The Board *may* provide financial assistance to extra-curricular activities on the basis of a per pupil allocation to be determined annually. Sums may be allocated directly to schools. Additional funds may be applied to district sponsored activities. Weighting factors may be considered to enable smaller elementary schools to gain full participation.
3. Allocated funding shall be applied against the cost of trips involving students and supervisors whether in or beyond the district. Costs of any extra-curricular events not normally covered under other sections of the budget shall be covered under this allocation.
4. After 6:00 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays, and all day Saturday and Sunday, schools must be booked with the school principal's office. Friday nights are reserved for school activities. The school principal will be responsible for supervision of students at any time school activities are in progress.
5. No outside fund-raising groups shall use schools during school hours without the specific approval of the Board.
