2515: Enrolment of Adults in Secondary Schools

Policy

The school principal may consider applications for enrolment in secondary schools from persons who are older than school age. For the purposes of this policy, an adult student is defined as being 19 years of age or over before September 1 in the current school year.

School Act Reference Section 75 (8)

Regulations

1. Applications from adult students for admission to a secondary school are to be made to the school principal.
2. Acceptance of an application is contingent upon
 - a) the prospective student's furnishing evidence that his or her ability and background indicate a reasonable chance of success in the course(s) to be attempted;
 - b) the school having sufficient accommodation for the student.
3. To continue in the course(s), the student shall meet school requirements and comply with all relevant regulations.
