This report is to verify that the following conditions are in place as per legislation Bill 33 of the School Act.

- 1) That School District 82 (Coast Mountains) has met the required class size legislation as of October 1, 2011.
 - a. All classes are within class size limits
 - b. District class size averages meet legislative requirements
 - i. Kindergarten class size – 18.6
 - ii. Primary class size – 20.9
 - iii. Intermediate class size – 24.78
 - iv. Secondary class size – 24.83
- 2) That all classes in School District 82 (Coast Mountains) are appropriate for learning.
