Safe Arrival, Absent or Late to School

Please call the office and inform us if your child is sick or is away from school for some other excused absence. As we only have one secretary and the mornings tend to be a very busy time, it is very helpful and less taxing on time if parents/guardians call and keep us informed of absences/lates. However, we will continue to do our best to call home as soon as attendances arrive in the office if we do not hear from parents. Students who arrive late must continue to check in at the office. If your child is leaving school early, please sign them out at the office.

Supervision

Morning supervision begins at 8:30. To assist with assuring your child's safety, please do not drop off prior to this time.

Student Supplies

Drop off/Pick Up

Please do not drop off and pick up students at the front of the school. This area becomes very congested and unsafe and parking here interferes with the arrival and departure of the school bus. The front of the school is clearly marked as no parking between 8:30 – 9:15 and 2:30 – 3:15. Please respect and obey the posted signs.
