GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the supervision of the Director of Facility Services and daily guidance of the Maintenance Foreman, installs, alters, repairs and maintains plumbing, heating, air conditioning and mechanical systems related to the maintenance, alteration and construction of district buildings and equipment; works as a member of a team to ensure the timely resolution of general district maintenance requirements, in accordance with applicable acts, regulations, policies and procedures.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- installs, upgrades and maintains plumbing, heating, cooling, ventilating and fire sprinkler systems
- maintains and repairs gas systems (science labs, heating systems, industrial arts)
- maintains test records required by Code and equipment history log books (e.g. fire equipment, sprinkler systems)
- cleans, checks/confirms operational safety and performs routine maintenance on working equipment on a daily basis; performs minor repairs, and recommends new/replacement equipment
- assists with or resolves a variety of maintenance problems as required (e.g. welding); salts, sands and clears ice and snow from exterior walkways, stairs and roofs as required
- reads and interprets drawings and specifications, determines material requirements, lays out projects, reports on work in progress, and proposes changes in plans and schedules as required

- assigns tasks, monitors quality, quantity, adherence to standard for maintenance employees as assigned; provides input to the performance review process
- maintains the confidentiality of sensitive information
- performs other related duties as required
