


Good Communication....

SAFETY TO AND FROM SCHOOL

- We all care about student safety. It is important that we continually stress the importance of using crosswalks, sidewalks and overpasses, and frequently remind students about following safe traffic and road rules.
- STOP THINK ACT
- Talk to your child about taking extra caution near busy intersections and corners.
- Students should be cautious and fully aware of their surroundings and avoid using their cell phones and listening to loud music.
- Skateboards, longboards, and scooters can be brought to school; however, it is crucial for students to follow safety and road rules. It is also essential that those riding skateboards, longboards, or scooters to and from school have the necessary equipment to protect their own personal safety. Helmets are required.
- If your child is bringing a skateboard, longboard or scooter they must bring these items into the office as soon as they arrive on school grounds. Students are not permitted to ride these before class, at lunch or break, or after school.
- If your child is bringing a bike to school, they must lock this up as soon as they arrive on grounds. Bikes are not to be ridden on school grounds.
