

Addition at home: Scavenger Hunt

Addition or adding is not always done with worksheets. We also carry out addition in our everyday lives. We can even do addition with objects around the house. By finding the objects in your house listed below, find the **SUM** of the **Addition** statements below. If you do not have one of the objects listed, make it a zero in your question. Mr. Holland does not have any crayons in his house so he would just use "0" for the number of crayons in questions #3.

1. Find the number of chairs in your house **PLUS** the number of forks in your kitchen
(Example: I have 4 chairs in my house **PLUS** 10 forks that EQUALS 14 ($4 + 10 = 14$))
2. Find the number of family members in your house **PLUS** the number of pets you have **PLUS** number of Pillows in your room
3. Find the number of markers you own **PLUS** number of pencil crayons **PLUS** number of pencils **PLUS** number of crayons in your house
4. Find the number of toys that you own **PLUS** the number of bowls in your kitchen
5. Find the number of doors in your house **PLUS** the number of light switches
6. Find the number of sinks in your house **PLUS** the number of shoes in your house **PLUS** the number of forks in your kitchen
7. Find the number of windows in your house **PLUS** the number of water bottles **PLUS** the number of plants in your house
8. Find the number of blankets in your house **PLUS** the number of pictures/paintings you can find **PLUS** the number of hats in your house
