Board of Education Regular (Public) Meeting Held Wednesday, September 24, 2025 - 5:00 p.m. Board of Education Office, Terrace & via Zoom

The meeting was called to order acknowledging the school district's business being conducted on the traditional territories of the Gitxsan, Haisla, Nisga'a, and Ts'msyen Peoples. Board Chair Warcup welcomed staff and guests joining in person and virtually to the first Regular Board Meeting of the 2025-2026 school year, also livestreamed via CMSD82's YouTube Channel.

Board Chair Warcup shared the start of the new school year was smooth, however, a busy start-up with staff and students returning to welcoming, safe and inclusive schools. September is a month of getting to know one another – students, staff and parents/caregivers – in an effort to build meaningful relationships and establishing a sense of community within classrooms and schools.

Trustees and District staff recognized and showed their support for Truth & Reconciliation Week 2025 and September 30 National Day for Truth & Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day.
