POLICY 3035: DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS ASSETS

Date Adopted: January 30, 2019

POLICY STATEMENT

The Board endorses the reasonable disposal of surplus equipment and assets.

POLICY

Equipment that is declared surplus shall be disposed of in accordance with the procedures in this policy.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Surplus assets deemed to have recoverable value are to be offered for disposal by the district in this order:
 - a. Used as a trade-in for a new asset.
 - b. For individual items with an estimated value of \$500.00 or more, they are to be sold by public offer via a bidding process on the Coast Mountains School District website. Individual items with an estimated value less than \$500.00 may be sold at fair market value.
 - c. Sold at a garage sale.
- 2. Proceeds from a sale of school assets are to be kept for use by the school.
- 3. Proceeds from a sale of assets made surplus by the closing of a school are to be received as district revenue.
- 4. Proceeds from a sale of district-level assets are to be received as district revenue.
- 5. Surplus assets that are deemed to have no recoverable value are to be recycled or otherwise disposed of.
